20. Historical Significance: In December of 1924 Teggerdine and King were granted a permit to build a fire proof building on lot between Town Hall and present Post Office. The building was then used for a Post Office with Floyd Andrews as Post Master. Mrs. Elizabeth Ronk was appointed Post Mistress in 1936; it continued there another ~~20~~ years and then moved to the present Post Office building. A bakery was in this building and then Kings Insurance Agency. At present it is a beauty shop.
