Plans approved, as specified, by the Commission on October 11, 2011.

This Commission is pleased to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness for proposed work at 15 East Church Street. The Commission approves:

An approximately 4-inch reveal of 5.25 HardiePlank lapsiding, applied horizontally with smooth-finish facing outward.

On October 18, 2011, the Commission ammended this Certificate of Appropriateness to include removal of the structure's east side door, which will then be covered with siding. Present members deemed that door unoriginal to the house, and that it didn't add substantial historical relevance to favor retaining it.

The project meets numbers nine and ten of the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation, which state that "... exterior alterations, or related new construction will not destroy historic materials, features, and spatial relationships that characterize the property..." and that work "... will be undertaken in a such a manner that, if removed in the future, the essential form and integrity of the historic property and its environment would be unimpaired."
