The Clarkston Historic District Commission approved a Certificate of Appropriateness at their October 10, 2017 meeting. The proposed work was for:

- 1) Remove window at the upper floor west elevation due to ongoing water damage caused by adjacent low roof drainage.

The window opening was stated to not be original to the house and is to be removed to prevent ongoing damage to the window and wall. Opening is to be closed in and siding added to match existing.

A Certificate of Appropriateness (CoA) is only approval for the requirements of the City of the Village of Clarkston Historic District and does not replace or supersede zoning, building construction permit, other city ordinance and legal requirements. A Historic District Commission CoA is valid for one year. If the approved work is not complete within that time, please contact the city office for review.
