The Clarkston Historic District Commission (HDC) approved a Certificate of Appropriateness (CoA) at their June 12, 2018 meeting for the application dated June 8, 2018. The approved work is as follows:

Repair or replace the existing garage doors due to the inability to open the existing doors, deteriorated wood and hardware. Doors are original horizontal sliding. New construction will be of 7 1/4" wide lumber, constructed *in a similar manner to the existing with vertical boards* and painted to match the original and existing condition and operation.

A Certificate of Appropriateness (CoA) is only approval for the requirements of the City of the Village of Clarkston Historic District and does not replace or supersede zoning, building construction permit, other city ordinance and legal requirements. A Historic District Commission CoA is valid for one year. If the approved work is not complete within that time, please contact the city office for review.
