Pursuant to an Application for Work Permit within the Clarkston Historic District filed on April 15, 2021, commissioners Jim Meloche and Michael Moon reviewed the documentation presented regarding the roof to be replaced.

Applicant provided photographs of the conventional shingles and the single-ply membrane portions of the roofing to be replaced. In addition, data sheets from Duro-Last (provider of the membrane system) and GAF (provider of the fiberglass asphaltic shingles) accompanied the application. These are direct replacements for the deteriorated roofing materials presently on the building.

Based on the information in the Application, and technical information provided:

- Duro-Last, Duro-Tuff 50 mil membrane
- GAF Timberline HD fiberglass asphaltic shingles

as well as a prior site visit by two HDC commissioners, Administrative Approval is granted for this work to be performed in the Clarkston Historic District.
