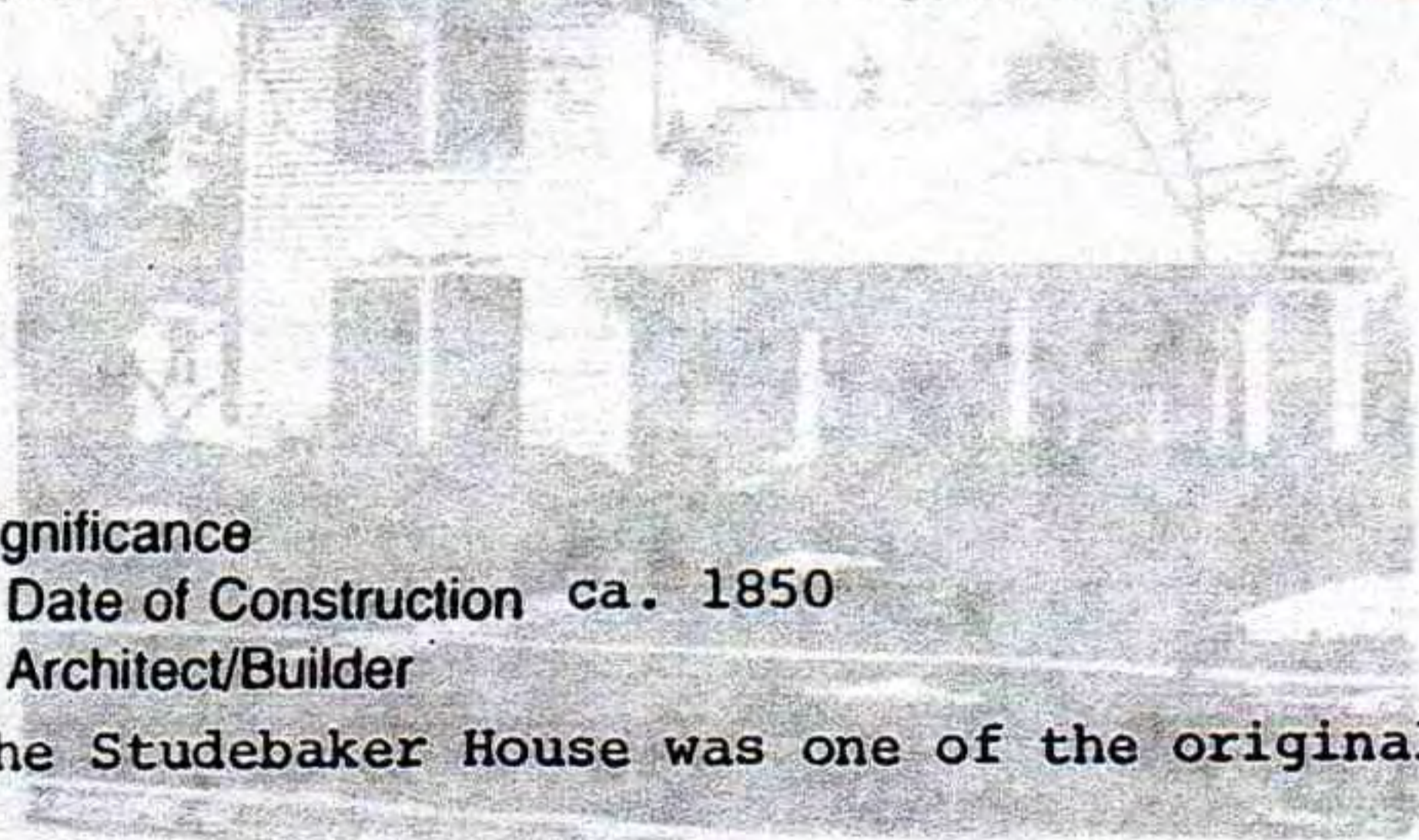

The Greek Revival roof of the two story and east porch of the one story portion has been changed from the original design. This wood frame structure has clapboard siding and rectangular windows.
