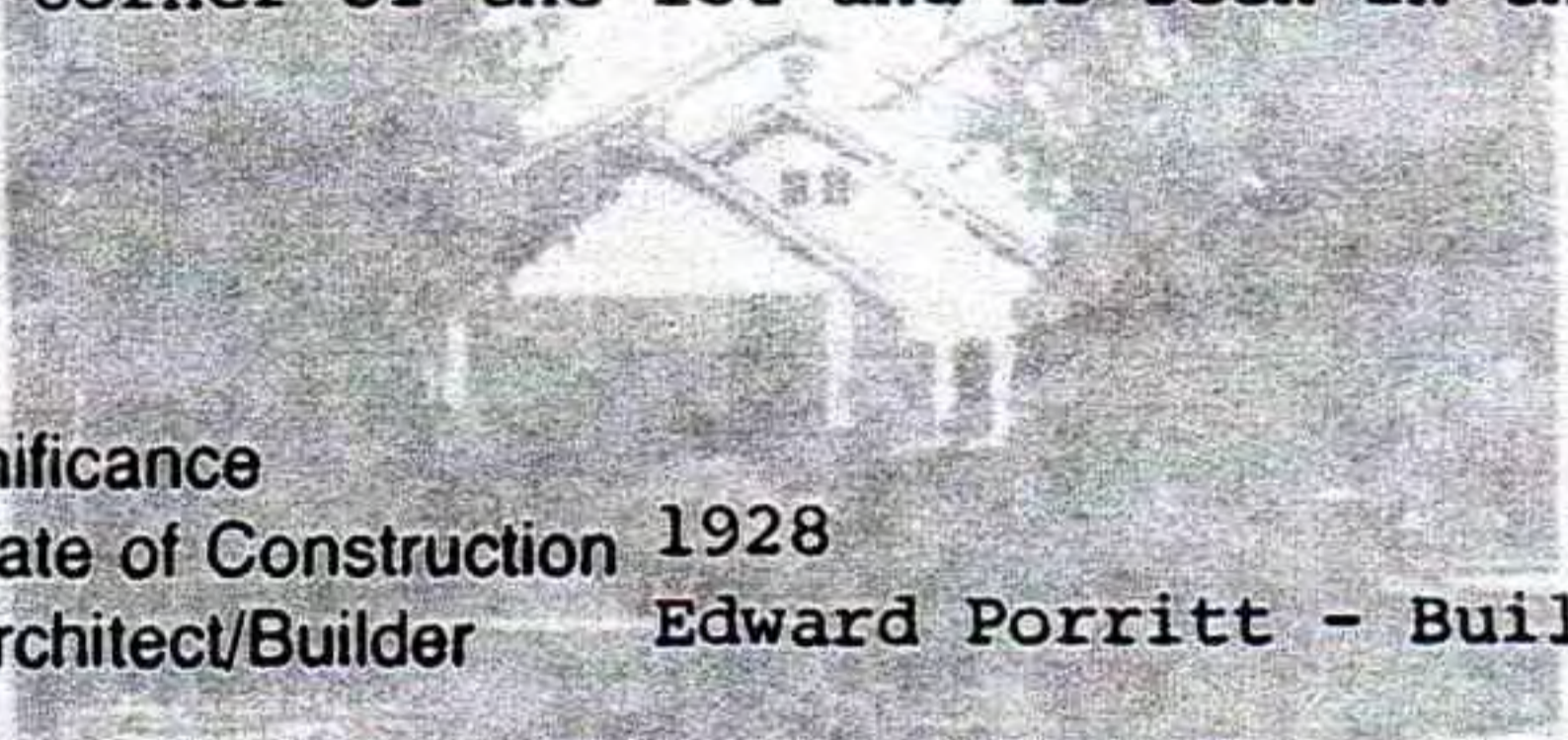

Description

The Chisholm House is a two-story wood frame, rectangular building on a field stone foundation. It has horizontal wood siding and rectangular windows. On the front of the house is a screen enclosed porch. The second story of the house was added around 1930 and consists of three bedrooms. A tall spruce is located on the north west corner of the lot and is seen in the front elevation.



Significance

The Porritt House is significant for its lake cottage use typical of many homes built in the late 20's and 30's in Clarkston.
