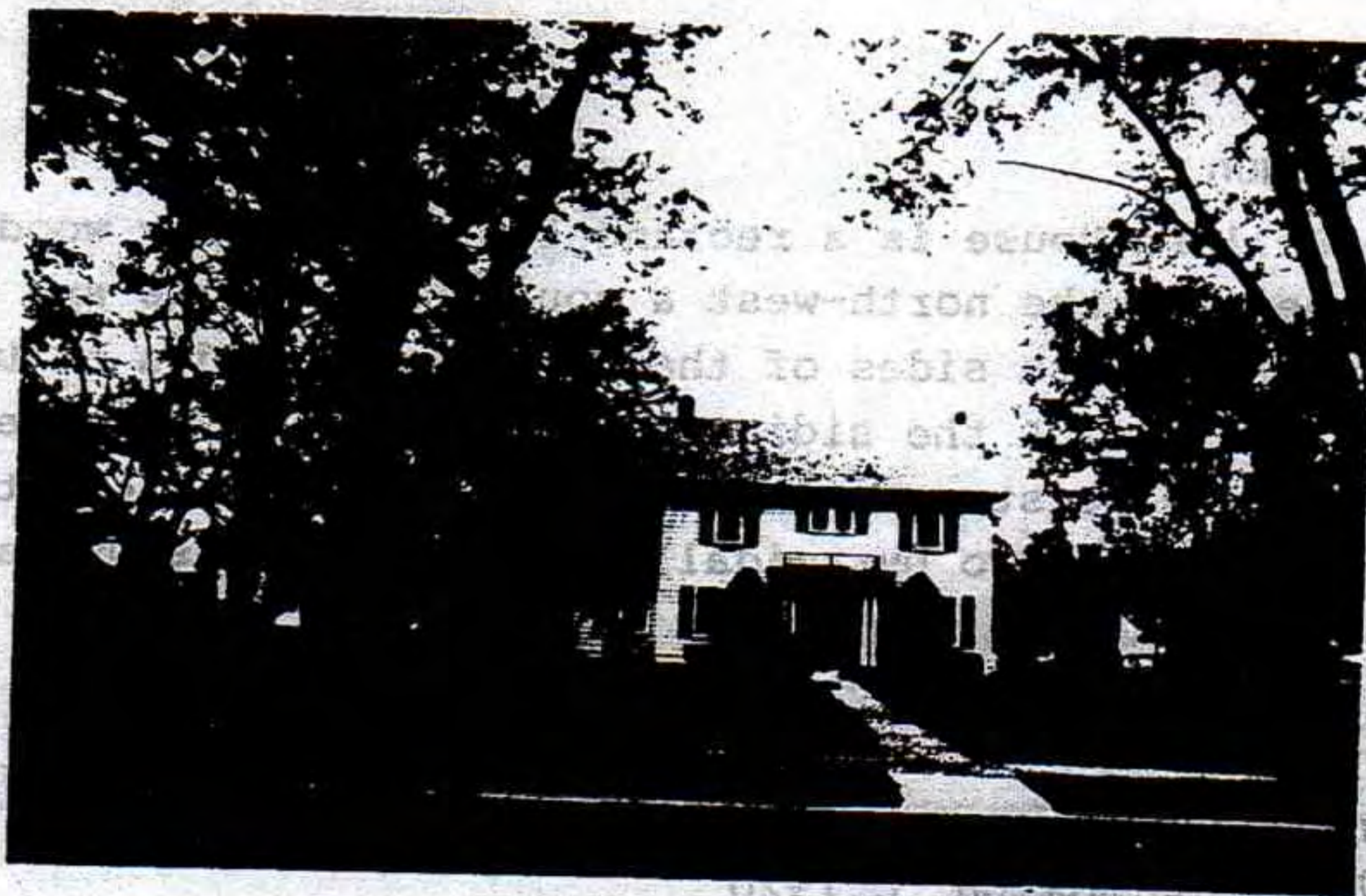

Description

The Bullard House is a rectangular 2 1/2 story wood frame structure. The main roof is pitched and the north-west & south porch roofs are flat. The south porch has double columns on both sides of the front entry and a balustrade on the roof. The foundation is fieldstone & the siding is clapboard. There are two flush chimneys on the east & west sides constructed of brick. Landscape elements include a gravel driveway, a swing set and two pyramidal shaped evergreens on each side of the front entry. The house is set back from the street further than houses on adjoining lots.

Significance

The Bullard House built, for Louis and Blanche Walter, is significant for its setting and as a Colonial Revival structure. This stately white 2 1/2 story structure stands at the corner of Washington & Holcomb streets, a well travelled, yet quiet intersection in Clarkston. Although not as large as some of the houses along mainstreet, the Bullard House is prominent in its surroundings of smaller more intimate homes.
